

1.1 TRANSFORMING LAND AND PEOPLE SYSTEMS

1.1.1 THE TRANSFORMATION SYSTEM

The issue of how the relationship between people and land is a fundamental transformational one from many perspectives. For example, we know that agriculture and land use are key sustainability issues. Related activities include development of eco-system services, landscape planning, nature-based solutions to climate change, environmentally sensitive agriculture, food systems, and indigenous peoples and land.

1.1.2 ACTION GOALS

Broad Goals

This ST will steward the emergence of land and people relationships that are in harmony with nature.

Three Year Goals

1. Gather intelligence about the diverse transformational land and people initiatives, networks and existing systems to understand their dynamics, structures, and development issues, and the different land and people approaches arising in the world;
2. Create a powerful ST that includes participation of diverse land and people transformations enablers and initiatives working towards the ST goals; and
3. To support entrepreneurial actions to advance development of land and people systems and infrastructure;
4. Work with the Forum and its parts to (1) support their own land and people system needs, and (2) provide vehicles for them to develop land and people approaches in their respective topics; and
5. Advance leading transforming land and people relationships knowledge and practice.

1.1.3 BUDGETED ACTIVITIES

1.1.3.1.1 YEAR 1: SEEING, CONNECTING

Land, People and Agriculture Transformations Systems: €140K

The work of this ST will focus on the analysing and convening around the topic of “land and food” and connect an important issue across Place-Based STs with more geographically broad and global work on the topic. This priority activity arises out of both the general importance of the issue, and the work of other STs and Forum participants, including communities, businesses and government activity. This activity will identify a ST, strategy and priority RALIs.
